SCHEDULING ORDER

THIS ORDER is entered _____, 2010.

Counsel have discussed with the Court their respective need for adequate discovery time, complexity of legal issues to be addressed, and their case load in arriving at this agreed Scheduling Order.

IT IS ORDERED that the following must be completed within the time fixed:

1. Neither JOINDER OF ADDITIONAL PARTIES : **Filed only with leave of court or written consent of opposing parties (12 O.S. sec. 2015)**
2. PRELIMINARY WITNESS & EXHIBIT LISTS (**including demonstrative exhibits**) exchanged by:

3. FINAL WITNESS & EXHIBIT LISTS exchanged by: _____ additional witness/exhibits shall **be stricken by the Court**, absent extraordinary circumstances. Exhibits, including **demonstrative** exhibits, must be exchanged 10 days prior to trial. Failure to comply with this paragraph will result in the **exclusion of witness/exhibits at trial**.
4. EXHIBITS are to be marked **and pre-admitted by agreement, if possible, by day of trial**.
5. ALL MOTIONS including dispositive motions (except motions in limine) _____.
6. MOTIONS IN LIMINE must be filed by: _____ or will not be considered. They can be heard the Monday morning before trial, unless counsel requests an earlier setting.
7. OBJECTION TO EXPERT TESTIMONY: Objections to expert witnesses shall be included in the Pretrial Conference Order; the Court will set a briefing schedule and a *Daubert* hearing date at the Pretrial.

8. PRETRIAL CONFERENCE DATE & TIME: _____

The Court strongly encourages mediation (either private or Early Settlement) but upon good faith discussion by counsel that mediation will be futile and subsequent representation to the Court may be waived.

Plaintiff must provide a proposed Pretrial Order fifteen (15) days before pretrial.
Defendant must complete and return the Pretrial Order no later than five (5) days prior to pretrial.

All trial exhibits must be pre-marked by number and the number must correlate with the numbers on the Pretrial Order. All documentary/photographic exhibits must be in a binder or notebook in compliance with the Oklahoma Supreme Court Rules for Appeals (Rule 13).
